Proposals under \$15,000 and approved by the Church Council may be funded directly.

Applications for \$15,000-\$25,000 and accepted by Council will be referred for approval by the Congregation.

Grants will be awarded at the discretion of the Outreach Grants Committee, Church Council, and/or the Congregation of First Congregational Church of Pasadena.

Applicants for grants will be notified of the Grants Committee / Church decision within 90 days after the application deadline.
